

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The Board of Education of Mundelein Elementary School District 75 will receive sealed bids from qualified vendors to design, furnish, and install a Notifier intelligent fire alarm system with voice notification and command capabilities at Lincoln Early Learning Center, 200 West Maple Street, Mundelein, IL 60060 (Project 75-2603).

Proposals will be received between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Central Time at the Mundelein School District 75 Administration Center, 470 N. Lake St., Mundelein, IL 60060, up to and no later than Monday, April 6, 2026, at 10:00 a.m., at which time they will be publicly opened.

A mandatory site walkthrough will be held on Monday, March 23, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. at Lincoln Early Learning Center, 200 W. Maple Street, Mundelein, IL 60060, Door #1 (in rear of building).

Questions related to the bid may be submitted, in writing, via email to vcarey@d75.org up to and no later than Wednesday, March 25, 2026, at 4:00 p.m. Questions will be answered via email in the form of an addendum to all potential bidders.

The Board of Education reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive informalities and irregularities in bidding procedures, and to accept the bid considered to be in the best interest of the District. Any such decision shall be considered final.

The successful Bidder must comply with, and acknowledge that the contract is subject to and governed by, the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130/1-12), which requires payment of prevailing wages to all laborers, workmen, and mechanics working on publicly funded projects. If, during the term of the work, these rates change, the Contractor shall be responsible for any additional costs without any change to the contract amount. The proposed contract is subject to the requirements of the Equal Employment Practices Commission and the Illinois Human Rights Act (HRA) (Section 2-105, 775 ILCS 5/2-105).
