A Note from our Social Workers

Is this a familiar situation? Your child comes home from school and they seem to be grumpier than usual. You asked how their day went. Your child says, "It was bad". You asked them what happened. Your child says, "I'm the dumbest kid in the class. I am always last to finish anything". You feel concerned and not sure what to say, but then you decide to try to shift their perspective. You asked, "What would you say to your friend if they felt this way"? You notice your child thinking and then they say, "I would tell them they are smart and to stop thinking they are dumb". You tell your child that they should be kind to themselves, they way they are kind to their friend. With practice, positive-self talk and growth mindset are two things that lead to building a child's self-esteem. You can practice this skill at home by printing out the "Talk to Yourself Like You Would Talk to a Friend" worksheet. Designed to encourage self-compassion and positive self-talk, this simple activity is a stepping stone towards building confidence in your child.
